About the Exam

The exam is administered exclusively by the New York State Board of Law Examiners and is held in New York State twice a year.

It comprises two elements:

- The New York State Bar Exam, the State-specific element which consists of 5 essay questions, 50 MCQs and 1 Multistate Performance Test Question.
- The Multistate Bar Exam or MBE, a test of common law which all prospective attorneys must take, regardless of the State in which they intend to practise.

These two elements are assessed over two days on the last Tuesday and Wednesday of every February and July. Dates for 2010 are 27 & 28 July 2010, dates for early 2011 are 22 & 23 February 2011.

Although it does not form part of the New York Bar Exam itself, all prospective US attorneys must also pass the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination (the MPRE), an ethics test, before they can be admitted. The MPRE dates in 2010 are March 6th, August 6th and November 6th. Candidates usually take this test after the New York Exam and the MBE, but it is possible to take it beforehand.

Step 1 - Register with the New York State Board of Law Examiners between 1st April and 30th April 2010 for the July 2010 sitting and between 1st and 30th November 2010 for the February 2011 sitting (apply online at www.nybarexam.org/). The registration fee is \$250.

Step 3 - Receive your textbooks and online login details.
